Welcome Back!

Helping Your Child Cope with Back-to-School Anxiety For most students, returning to school or starting school for the first time is a very exciting time! It's another sign that they are growing and gaining maturity. Gheir excitement should be honored and celebrated! However, some children find returning to school challenging.

According to Anxiety BC "anxious feelings are normal and expected during times of transition", which includes going back to school or starting school for the first time! Your worried child may cling, cry, have temper tantrums, complain of head or stomach aches, or become irritable.

Worries are common, Some common worries include "What if my new teacher is mean? Will any of my friends be in my class? Are my clothes ok? What if I miss the bus?" and so on,

"Although it is normal for your child to have worries, it is crucial to make your child attend school, Avoidance of school will only increase and reinforce your child's fears over the long-term and make it increasingly more difficult to attend"

Counsellor Introduction to Bertha Kennedy

Greetings from the Bertha Kennedy's New School Counsellor,

My name is Maria Watkins. I am very pleased to inform you that this year I will be working as the part-time/itinerant School Counsellor at Bertha Kennedy. I have worked as a school counsellor in the district since 2010. In fact, I have worked at most of the Catholic Elementary Schools in St. Albert except your school and JJ Nearing. My school counselling career has now spanned nineteen years. I am very excited to be working at Bertha Kennedy. I look forward to working with the Bertha Kennedy Community.

I have a master's degree in counselling psychology from the University of Alberta. I am registered and certified by the Canada Counselling and Psychotherapy Association (CCC) and the Alberta Counselling Therapist Association (ACTA). I have worked in the public and private sector as a school counsellor and psychotherapist. In my work as a counsellor, I use a competency-based counselling model to assist students to find their own way out of problem situations. Narrative School Counselling is a respectful, non-blaming and collaborative counselling approach. I am trained in asking questions that separate children from problems which opens up space from them to experience agency. In addition, I am skilled at asking questions that connect children with their skills, competencies, beliefs, values, commitments and abilities. This process aligns the child (person) with preferences as well as preferred future possibilities for her (his) life.

I am thrilled to be allocated a .4FTE with Bertha Kennedy. I have arranged my schedule to be at BK four half days a week. I will be here on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons between 12:00 until 3:30.
