Student Safety:

Bertha Kennedy scores in the excellent range on the Safe and Caring Alberta School Education Assurance Measure Survey. This year, 96% of students, parents, and staff reported that they felt safe and well cared for. This has increased since the previous year and is nearly 7% higher than the provincial average.



Inclusive Learning:

Bertha Kennedy is an inclusive school. We make use of formative and diagnostic assessments to guide our instruction and are committed to differentiation so that all students are able to reach their full learning potential. Our Diverse Learning team is active in classrooms to reach the needs of all students. We provide equitable access to technology, differentiated lessons, hands-on learning, and positive behaviour support. Staff are committed to continued learning by incorporating Practice Progressions and Concept-Based Learning in all of their lessons.
