Bring Your Own Robust Device (BYORD)

Robust Technology Device: Although we won't recommend specific models or kinds of devices, we encourage you to by a device that features the following for the best learning results:

- Wireless networking capability (the Division provides filtered wireless access in all buildings for students)
- A microphone
- An external keyboard for entering text
- o Audio output for earbuds or headphones
- A minimum of 6 hours of use from one battery charge
- A full-functioning, recent Chrome web browser that will allow access to Google Apps for Education tools and documents
- o A sturdy carrying case (NO backpack) that will protect the device
- An integrated camera that takes both still photos and video

There is no perfect device, however, the following are examples of devices that meet the criteria above:

- 1. Chromebooks (ex. Asus Chromebook, Acer Chromebook, HP Chromebook Samsung Chromebook)
- 2. Laptop (ex. Macbook Pro, Macbook Air, Acer Aspire, HP laptop, Toshiba Satellite Laptop)

Students will only be permitted to use their own devices at school if the "Learning with Technology: Responsible Use Agreement has been completed. Please review with your child.
